1115.03 APPLICABILITY.

Unless otherwise provided herein, a permit for signage shall be required for all signs placed, constructed, erected, relocated, refaced, or modified on a development site within the Village of Cadiz. Such permit shall be secured in conformance with the provisions set forth herein and by payment of the fees specified in Section <u>1127.13</u> (Schedule of Fees, Charges and Expenses). (Ord. 2014-50. Passed 12-18-14.)

1115.04 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SIGNS AND DISTRICTS.

The regulations contained in this section shall apply to all signs and use districts:

(a) Any illuminated sign or lighting device shall employ only light emitting a light of constant intensity; and no sign shall be illuminated or containing flashing, intermittent, rotating, or moving light or lights. In no event shall an illuminated sign or lighting device be placed or directed so as to permit the beams and illumination therefrom to be directed or beamed upon a public thoroughfare, highway, sidewalk or adjacent premises so as to cause glare or reflection that may constitute a traffic hazard or nuisance.

(b) No sign shall employ any parts or elements which revolve, rotate, whirl, spin or otherwise make use of motion to attract attention or flags or pennants. Subsections (a) and (b) of this section shall not apply to any sign performing a public service function indicating time, temperature, news updates or similar services.

(c) All wiring, fittings and materials used in the construction, connection, operation and maintenance of electrically illuminated signs shall be in accordance with the provisions of the State of Ohio Electrical Code.

(d) No projecting sign shall be erected or maintained from the front or face of a building a distance of more than thirty-six (36) inches, including those projecting from the face of any theater, hotel or motel marquee.

(e) No sign of any classification shall be installed, erected, or attached in any form, shape, or manner to a fire escape or any door or window giving access to any fire escape.

(f) All signs hung and erected shall be plainly marked with the name of the person, firm, or corporation responsible.

(g) Should any sign be or become unsafe or be in danger of falling, the owner thereof or the person maintaining the same, shall, upon receipt from the Zoning Administrator, proceed at once to put such sign in a safe and secure condition or remove the sign.

(h) No sign shall be placed in any public right-of-way except publicly owned signs, such as traffic control signs and directional signs.

(i) Signs directing and guiding traffic and parking on private property, but bearing no advertising matter shall be permitted on any property.

1115.05 MEASURE OF SIGN AREA.

The surface area of a sign shall be computed as including the entire area within a regular, geometric form or combinations of regular, geometric forms comprising all of the display area of the sign and including all of the elements of the matter displayed. Frames and structural frames not being advertising matter shall not be included in computation of surface area. The computation applies to each face of the freestanding sign (Example: a 40 square foot sign allows two faces of 40 square feet each). (Ord. 2014-50. Passed 12-18-14.)

1115.06 SIGNS PERMITTED IN ALL DISTRICTS AND NOT REQUIRING A PERMIT.

(a) Signs advertising the sale, lease, rental of the premises upon which the sign is located, shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet in area, except in residential districts where the area of the sign shall not be more than eight (8) square feet.

(b) Professional name plates shall not exceed two (2) square feet in area. (Ord. 2014-50. Passed 12-18-14.)

1115.07 SIGNS PERMITTED AND REQUIRING A PERMIT.

(a) All signs in the Architectural Design District, C-1 Commercial and M-1 Manufacturing Districts require sign permits.

(b) Signs and their respective sizes per zoning district shall be as follows:

1115.08 TEMPORARY SIGNS: CONTRACTORS, ARCHITECTS AND BUILDERS.

Temporary signs not exceeding thirty-two (32) square feet in area, announcing the construction of a building, the architect, the builders, and/or contractors may be erected for a period of sixty (60) days plus the construction period. (Ord. 2014-50. Passed 12-18-14.)

1115.09 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT: SIGNS FOR MULTI-TENANT BUILDERS.

(a) <u>Freestanding Signs.</u> Freestanding on-premises signs shall be a maximum of fifteen (15) feet in height, having a maximum of fifty (50) square feet per display area (sign face) and located not closer than ten (10) feet to any street right-of-way line and not closer than thirty (30) feet to any adjoining lot line and may be erected to serve a group of

five or more business establishments and/or commercial tenants. There shall be only one freestanding sign for multi-tenant buildings.

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(b) <u>Wall Signs.</u> Wall signs are permitted; however, they are not to exceed an are equivalent to one and one-half (1 1/2) square feet per lineal foot of the building or business frontage. (Ord. 2014-50. Passed 12-18-14.)
